

Why is domain information public?

Domain privacy prevents ownership information from being publicly displayed in WHOIS queries. The Internet Corporation of Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) requires that all domains are associated with valid contact information of the owner, including name, address, phone number and email address. This personal information is publicly available so owners of domain names can be contacted if needed. Without domain privacy, anyone can view this information when they perform a WHOIS search.

Unfortunately, this information also serves as a resource for those seeking to cause harm, including:

- · Potential identity theft
- · Unsolicited phone calls and mail
- · Email spam and phishing attacks
- · Unauthorized domain transfer requests

Why purchase domain privacy?

Domain Privacy can be activated on any or all of your Bluehost-registered domain names. When enabled, any personal information associated with the domain name is replaced and masked with the contact information of Bluehost.com.
